Public comment speakers are expected to abide by Board Policy 1312, *Civility Policy*, which promotes mutual respect, civility, and orderly conduct among district employees, parents, and the public. This policy is not intended to

deprive any person of his/her right to freedom of expression, but only to maintain, to the extent possible and reasonable, a safe, harassment-free environment. Any individual who disrupts or threatens to disrupt school/office operations; threatens the health and safety of students or staff; willfully causes property damage; uses loud and/or offensive language which could provoke a violent reaction; or who has otherwise established a continued pattern of unauthorized entry on school district property, will be directed to leave school or school district property promptly.

Education Code 220 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability, gender, gender identity, gender expression, nationality, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other characteristic that is contained in the definition of hate crimes set forth in Section 422.55 of the Penal Code, including immigration status.

Public speakers shall be allocated a maximum of three (3) minutes to address the board regarding any item or items. The number of minutes allowed for each speaker shall be determined by the number of speakers who submit their names prior to the beginning of public comment. When translation is requested, up to three additional minutes will be provided for English translation.

- 1-10 speakers: 3 minutes each
- 11-15 speakers: 2 minutes each
- 16-30 speakers: 1.5 minutes each
- 31+ speakers: 1 minute each
